

## Waiver Application for the Talented and Gifted Endorsement

### Instructions:

1. **Individuals who were licensed in Iowa prior to August 31, 1995, and were allowed to teach talented and gifted classes without completing the endorsement requirements must complete the endorsement requirements by July 1, 2012, in order to teach or continue to teach talented and gifted classes. This waiver provision is provided through the Board of Educational Examiners for individuals who have been successfully teaching students who are talented and gifted.**
2. **The fee for the evaluation is \$60 and the fee to add the TAG endorsement is \$50. Make the check or money order made payable to the Board of Educational Examiners for \$110. All fees are nonrefundable.**
3. **Please allow four weeks for the review of the waiver request. The review committee meets once a month.**

## REQUIREMENTS for WAIVER

#	Criteria	Requirements for Waiver
	Introductory Page	One page biography introducing yourself, including your experiences in gifted education and interest in fulfilling requirements for the Iowa talented and gifted endorsement waiver.
1	Experience	Must submit verification of successful teaching experience in gifted programming signed by the administrator. (Experience in teaching honors or AP classes does not apply). If fewer than three years of experience, no waiver application will be considered.
2	Administrator Recommendation	Must include recommendation from the administrator on school letterhead. The recommendation should provide evidence of knowledge and skills in teaching students who are in gifted programs. If there is no recommendation from the administrator, no waiver application will be considered.
3	University or College Coursework	Must submit official transcripts of college course work in talented and gifted education. No electronic transcripts will be accepted. If the transcripts are being sent directly from the institution, include a note indicating this information.
4	Staff Development Coursework	Must submit official AEA transcripts of staff development course work in talented and gifted instruction. No copies will be accepted.
	Artifacts representing knowledge and skill	Content knowledge and skill may be evidenced through reflections and supportive artifacts if staff development course work has not been completed. These artifacts must be labeled as representation for each criteria. A one page reflection submitted with the supportive artifacts must indicate how the applicant verifies knowledge and skill in this area.
	Required Points	A total of 12 points in categories 3 and 4 must be earned for the waiver application to be submitted for consideration. The highest point value in the criteria area earned will be assessed. There is no accumulation of points in course criteria.



## REVIEW CRITERIA FOR THE TAG WAIVER

### REVIEW CRITERIA

#### #1 Teaching experience (4 points maximum possible)

If fewer than three years of experience, no waiver application will be considered.

3	8-10 years of teaching experience in gifted programming
2	5-7 years of teaching experience in gifted programming
1	3-4 years of teaching experience in gifted programming

#### #2 Administrator Recommendation (2 points possible)

If there is no recommendation from the administrator, no waiver application will be considered.
