Hearing Dogs undergo at least two months training at the PAWS® Training Center where they learn to alert hearing impaired/deaf individuals to sounds that demand attention. All Hearing Dogs are trained to alert their owner to basic sounds like: a smoke alarm, an intruder, an alarm clock, the doorbell, a knock at the door, and the telephone/TDD ring. In all cases but that of the smoke alarm, the dog is trained to bring the client to the sound. In the case of the smoke alarm, the dog is trained to take the client to the nearest exit. The trained dog goes through an additional two months of training in the home of the client under the direction of a local Field Instructor.
